Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What kind of clothing can be used in a Quintessential Quilt?

A: Whatever you have, I will make work! I can work with most materials (non-tee shirts - cottons, oxfords, prints, plaids, silks, wool, blazers, sweaters, fleece, etc.).

Q: How many articles of clothing go into a quilt?

A: The size of the quilt depends on how many shirts/pants/sweaters you have. Sizes range and can be customized to your needs. As a suggestion, an oversized throw is a great starting point for most. If you have a lot of clothing that is great-I have no problem with you sending more rather than less.

As a BALLPARK frame of reference I would need 10+ articles of clothing for each oversized throw. If you only have 10 or less, I can add to it with alternating squares of my own fabric (cotton).

Once I get the garments I can give you more detailed info on size and design. Your quilt ultimately depends on you!

Q: Can a quilt be personalized?

A: Yes. I work with an exemplary embroiderer who can personalize your quilt with names, dates, favorite sayings, motifs, and more.

Q: How much does a quilt cost?

A: Prices are contingent upon size, garment type, and fabric.
